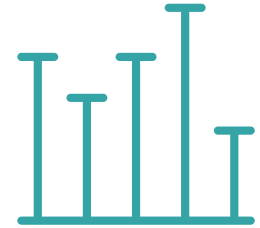


2024 STIFF PERSON SYNDROME SYMPOSIUM



Take-Away: Research in SPS: Past, Present, and Future

Recent studies have shown that Stiff Person Syndrome is a spectrum disorder (presents differently) and that it is more common than once thought.



Early markers of future disability have been identified, along with blood markers that are associated with the burden of disease.

Studies have demonstrated that certain immune treatments can help people with Stiff Person Syndrome, but further treatments are needed, including treatments that can improve function and, most importantly, cure SPS.
